Instruction for preparation of your power-point presentation

Special thanks to the distinguished speakers for making this happened. To help us smoothing the symposium event and in order to ease speakers for preparation of their power-point presentation, please kindly follow the instruction below:

[1] Time allocation for each presentation

Since there are a large number of speakers devotedly and voluntarily making presentations in the symposium event on 26-27 August 2010, ATRANS has done its best to allot the time to fit with the program, (see also the attached program).

- Each speaker will have 15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for questions & answers. Note that there will be a discussion at the end of each session as well.
- Please kindly develop your ppt. presentation to fit with the time allotted.

[2] Structure of Presentation

The speakers/ presenters may arrange their ppt. presentation as follows:

- 1) Introduce situation and problems concerning the presentation topic in connection with the theme of the symposium.
- 2) Present what have been done whether success or failure and are doing and plan to do in the future (if any)
- 3) Explain from your perspective point of view: what should be done in coming future or immediate remedial action or necessary researches in future or required collaborative work for interdisciplinary research and expectation for ATRANS activities, etc.

[3] Instruction to develop Power Point Presentation

- 1) Number of slides: The maximum number should be no more than 10 - 15 pages
- 2) Language: English or Thai (or vice versa)
- 3) Note that only Session 3A: Panel Discussion of Road Safety (Safety, Equity and Efficiency in Transportation), the speakers may present their ppt. presentation in Thai.

[4] Submission of ppt. presentation file

ATRANS will distribute symposium's reading materials to all participating audiences. To help us organizing the event smoothly, please submit your ppt. presentation in e-file no later than 10 August to pake.atrans@gmail.com and puandnote@gmail.com. The slides should be in ppt. format.

[5] Submission of your brief personal profile

Note that when submitting the electronic ppt file, please kindly submit your personal profile with picture if available so that the session chair can introduce you to the audiences correctly and properly.
