




TOD (by "Wikipedia")

Japan's System 1

City Planning Act

Article 11 (1) In city planning areas, the following facilities shall be stipulated as necessary in city plans:

(i) Roads, <u>urban rapid-transit railroads</u>, parking places, <u>motor vehicle terminals and other traffic facilities</u>


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<u>Article 53 (1)</u> Persons who intend to build buildings within areas of the city planning facilities...<u>shall obtain permission</u> from the prefectural governors pursuant to the provision of the Ordinance of the MLIT.

-> Control future developments

Japan's System 2
