



Dr. Agachai Sumalee (www.cse.polyu.edu.hk/~ceasumal) holds B.Eng in Civil Engineering (KMITL-Ladkrabang), MSc (Eng) and PhD in Transportation Planning and Engineering (ITS, Leeds University). His research areas are sustainable transport policy, intelligent transport system, network modelling and optimisation, transport economics, logistic optimisation, and transit network planning. Dr. Sumalee has published more than 50 research papers in top peer-reviewed journals (e.g. Transportation Research Part B, Part A, Part C, Transportation, Networks and Spatial Economics, Transportmetrica) on these research topics. He has received several prizes and awards for his research works including the Hans-Jürgen Ewers Prize for international outstanding research in infrastructure economics, the Smeed Prize, and twice outstanding paper awards at the EASTS conferences in Fukuoka and Bangkok. Dr. Sumalee has also secured several research grants from the Hong Kong RGC, UK Department for Transportation, Volvo Research Foundation, and European Commission. He is currently the Editor of Journal of Transport Policy (SCI journal), Associate Editor of Networks and Spatial Economics (SCI journal), and Editorial Board Member of Journal of Advanced Transportation (SCI journal). In 2008, he served as a member of sub-committee of Mass Transit Railway of the State Railway of Thailand. He is current a committee member of the US

Transportation Research Board Network Modelling Committee (U.S. National Research Council).
